Object caching is a common feature in the scalable distributed object systems. Fine-grained replication optimizes performance and resource utilization in object caching by enabling a remote object-oriented application to be partitioned incrementally on-demand replicated in units of cluster. 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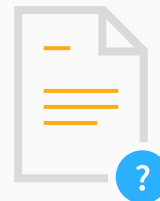
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
